THE $85 \%$ OF THE BUSINESS LANDSCAPE IS MADE UP OF SMEs SPECIALIZED IN: ELECTRONICS, ICTs, ADVANCED MATERIALS AND AERONAUTICAL AND AIRPORT SERVICES. THE FACTORIES PRODUCE COMPONENTS FOR THE ARIANE AND VEGA LAUNCHERS, SATELLITES, RADARS AND EQUIPMENT FOR AIRCRAFT AND HELICOPTERS.

## R\&D NETWORK

THE AEROSPACE INNOVATION ECOSYSTEM host the major universities and research centers of big enterprises (multinational) and innovative SMEs, that provide: components, services and technical/industrial support. It covers all areas from research to planning, from design to manufacturing and services.

## SANOFI

- Partnership with GSK to develop a COVID-19 vaccine
- Investment in the site of Anagni for the production of the vaccine
- The company aims at a production of 1 bln doses by 2021 - a huge part will be produced in Anagni


## IRBM - CATALENT

- AstraZeneca, the Univeristy of Oxford and Irbm of Pomezia (Rome) are developing a COVID-19 vaccine
- Catalent will take care of the vaccine bottling in its production site in Anagni
- It is expected that the production site will deliver 400 mln doses


## REITHERA

Biopharmaceutical company based in Castel Romano (Rome)
It has developed and produced a COVID-19 vaccine
In August 2020, the company has started the Phase 1 clinical trial along with the INMI Spallanzani Hospital (Rome)

## MENARINI

- Partnering with Tuscany Life Sciences Foundation on the MabCo19 project
- Menarini's biotech plant in Pomezia (Rome) started the production of the new drug
- The drug consists of a mixture of monoclonal antibodies that neutralise the SARS-CoV-2 spike protein
